Sermon

The Creed

All We believe in one God, the Father the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father.

God from God, Light from Light true God from true God, begotten not made, of one being with the Father, through him all things were made.

For us and for our salvation, he came down from heaven, was incarnate from the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary, and was made man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again, in accordance with the Scriptures, he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son;

who, with the Father and the Son,
is worshipped and glorified;
who has spoken through the prophets.

We believe in one holy Catholic and Apostolic church.
We acknowledge one baptism
for the forgiveness of sins.
We look for the resurrection of the dead,
and the life of the world to come.

Lead How wonderful the work of your hands O Lord. As a

At the end of supper, taking the cup of wine he gave you
thanks and said:

Drink this all of you, this is my blood of the new covenant
which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of
sins.

Do this as often as you drink it in remembrance of me.

Let us proclaim the mystery of faith:

All Christ has died.
Christ is risen.
Christ will come again.

Lead Father we plead with confidence his sacrifice made once
for all upon the cross. We remember his dying and rising in
glory and we rejoice that he intercedes for us at your right
hand.

Pour out your Holy Spirit as we bring before you these gifts
of your creation; may they be for us the body and blood of
your dear Son.

As we eat and drink these holy things in your presence
form us in the likeness of Christ and build us into a living
temple to your glory.

Remember Lord your Church in every land. Reveal her
unity, guard her faith and preserve her in peace.

Bring us at the last with all the saints to the vision of that
eternal splendour for which you have created us, through
Jesus Christ our Lord by whom, with whom and in whom,
with all who stand before you in earth and heaven we
worship you Father almighty in songs of everlasting praise.
