We believe in one God ΑII the Father, the Almighty maker of heaven and earth of all that is seen and unseen We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ the only Son of God eternally begotten of the Father God from God, Light from Light true God from true God begotten, not made of one Being with the Father through him all things were made For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven. was incarnate from the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary and was made man For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate he suffered death and was buried On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end We believe in the Holy Spirit the Lord, the giver of life who proceeds from the Father and the Son

who with the Father and the Son is worshipped and glorified who has spoken through the prophets

We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church

We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins

We look for the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come

Again he praised you, gave it to them and said

'Drink this, all of you, this is my blood of the new covenant
which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins

Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me'

So, Father, we remember all that Jesus did
in him we plead with confidence his sacrifice made once for all
upon the cross

Bringing before you the bread of life and cup of salvation
we proclaim his death and resurrection

Praise to you Lord Jesus

until he comes in glory

All Dying you destroyed our death rising you restored our life Lord Jesus, come in glory

Lord of all life
help us to work together for that day
when your kingdom comes
and justice and mercy will be seen in all the earth
Look with favour on your people
gather us in your loving arms
and bring us with all the saints
to feast at your table in heaven
Through Christ, and with Christ, and in Christ
