### *Prayers of Penitence*

Our Lord Jesus Christ said:

The first commandment is this: 'Hear O Israel, the Lord our God is the only Lord. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' The second is this: 'Love your neighbour as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

## *The Creed*

**All** We believe in one God  
the Father, the Almighty

begotten, not made  
of one Being with the Father  
through him all things were made

For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven  
was incarnate from the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary  
and was made man

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate  
he suffered death and was buried

On the third day he rose again  
in accordance with the Scriptures  
he ascended into heaven  
and is seated at the right hand of the Father

He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead  
and his kingdom will have no end

We believe in the Holy Spirit  
the Lord, the giver of life  
who proceeds from the Father and the Son

### *The Eucharistic Prayer*

The Lord is here

**All His Spirit is with us**

Lift up your hearts

**All We lift them to the Lord**

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God

**All It is right to give thanks and praise**

Father, you made the world and love your creation

You gave your Son Jesus Christ to be our Saviour

His dying and rising have set us free from sin and death

And so we gladly thank you

with saints and angels praising you, and saying

**All Holy, holy, holy Lord**

**God of power and might**

**heaven and earth are full of your glory**

**Hosanna in the highest**

**Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord  
Hosanna in the highest**

We praise and bless you, loving Father  
through Jesus Christ, our Lord  
and as we obey his command  
send your Holy Spirit  
that broken bread and wine outpoured  
may be for us the body and blood of your dear Son

On the night before he died he had supper with his friends  
and, taking bread, he praised you

He broke the bread, gave it to them and said  
'Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you,  
do this in remembrance of me'

When supper was ended he took the cup of wine

Again he praised you, gave it to them and said

'Drink this, all of you, this is my blood of the new covenant  
which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins  
Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me'

So, Father, we remember all that Jesus did

in him we plead with confidence his sacrifice made once for all  
upon the cross

Bringing before you the bread of life and cup of salvation

we proclaim his death and resurrection

until he comes in glory

Praise to you Lord Jesus



**All**     **Dying you destroyed our death**  
**rising you restored our life**  
**Lord Jesus, come in glory**

Lord of all life  
help us to work together for that day  
when your kingdom comes  
and justice and mercy will be seen in all the earth  
Look with favour on your people

so that we and all your children shall be free  
and the whole earth live to praise your name  
through Christ our Lord  
Amen
