The following liturgy is taken from 'Prayer with the harp of the Spirit' which is a translation of the original 4th Century Aramaic by Francis Acharya.

All **Compassionate Lord, we praise your wonderful name,
show us your mercy.**

Praise and thanksgiving to Christ the lord our redeemer, and giver of life, who came to us that we might have life and have it in full. To Him belongs glory, honour and adoration.

Matthew 26: 26-30: The Institution of the Lord's Supper

While they were eating, Jesus took a loaf of bread, and after blessing it he broke it, gave it to the disciples, and said, 'Take, eat; this is my body.' Then he took a cup, and after giving thanks he gave it to them, saying, 'Drink from it, all of you; for this is my blood of the [d] covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. I tell you, I will never again drink of this fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom.'

All **Therefore we beseech you, Lord, give us your Spirit according to your promise, the Spirit of wisdom and perception of what is given to those who believe in you. Him who Himself receives the entire fullness of God, that we may offer praise unceasingly and worship in spirit and in truth, to you and your Father and your Holy Spirit, now and always and for ever Amen.

Glory to the Father who sent His Son for our salvation.
Adoration to the Son who according to his Economy trod our earth.
Thanksgiving to the Holy Spirit who sanctifies the world,
And while hovering over it gives it new life.
